

Using your Vacation Premise Alert Form:

Print the directions on one page and the form on two sides of one page.

When going on vacation fill this form out and attach a recent photo of your special needs individual

Where it says medical condition list the most significant diagnosis

Write your VACATION address not your home address.

Write your CELL PHONE NUMBER THAT YOU CARRY WITH YOU AS WELL AS LAND LINE OF THE ADDRESS YOU ARE STAYING AT. NOT Your home phone number

Upon arrival in a vacation area make your first stop the local police station. Don't take the whole family just one family member if possible. Ask to speak to the officer in charge and explain that you have a special needs individual and you will be in the area. Ask them to let their officers know during roll call.

If you are in a resort talk to the concierge about the security department in the resort or if you should give it to the local police. A lot depends on if you will stay only in the resort or if you will be going out and what security is like where you are staying.

Make temporary tattoos on a computer put ONLY the child's last name and a cell phone number in a place that is typically covered by a shirt. Use a font that is not easily read at a distance. Something fancy and interesting that can be read up close. Don't put a lot of identifying information on that tattoo.

When you leave just make a call to the department and thank them even if you don't need to make an emergency call.
